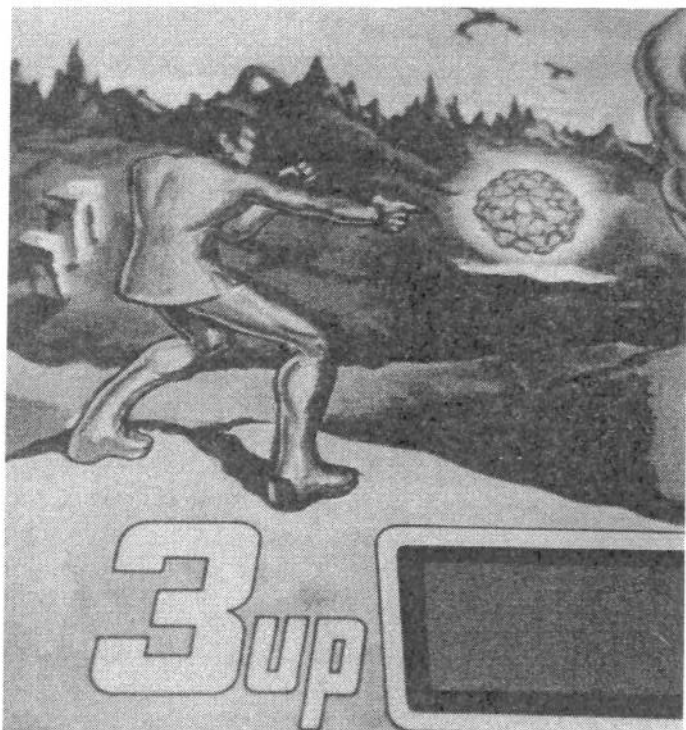


NAME THAT GAME GAME *by Herb Silvers*
